Pool Rules

Pool Rules and Regulations

- Open from 10:00am-10:00pm every day
- No lifeguards on duty so swim at your own risk
- The pool shall not be used during inclement weather
- No diving or acrobatic entry
- No running, roughhousing, or offensive behavior
- No smoking inside pool area
- · No glass containers inside pool area
- No bicycles, skateboards, or rollerblades
- No children under the age of 14 without an adult
- All infants (not potty trained) shall wear swim diaper or appropriate swimwear. Members will be assessed a \$100 pool cleanup fee if the pool must be closed and sanitized after an accident
- No pets allowed
- No floatation items filled with "bean bag" Styrofoam pellets
- Eating is allowed only in the designated area
- This is our association pool, so leave it in an orderly condition. Please cleanup and don't mistreat the pool property. Members who create a mess and fail to cleanup will be charged a \$50 fee plus any charges for damaged property.
- Our pool is for exclusive use of Symphony Hills members and their quests
- Members are asked to use their judgment and limit guests to a reasonable amount so as not to hinder other members' enjoyment of our pool. For example, no sporting team parties, birthday parties or large groups
- Parents or guardians will be responsible and liable for the actions of all children under their supervision
- Swimsuits only, street clothes of any kind are not permitted in the water

Hygiene Rules

- All persons using swimming pool shall have taken a cleansing shower/bath before entering the pool
- Any person having an infectious or communicable disease / illness shall be excluded from the pool

When a violation is identified, it is documented and a notice is sent to the member. Members who receive a notice are asked to please work with Centennial Management to remedy it.
